Church-based Groups

The mission of Moms in Prayer International, an interdenominational prayer ministry previously named Moms In Touch, is to impact children and schools worldwide for Christ by gathering mothers to pray regularly (weekly is optimal). Women in a local community may choose to meet together in an area church to pray for their children and the schools they attend. Several schools and all ages of children may be represented. During the intercession time, members are grouped by the ages of their children or by similar schools. Ideally, each school represented would be prayed for each week.

To begin

- Read the *Booklet* thoroughly and become familiar with the Four Steps of Prayer and One Accord Praying.
- Agree with the Moms in Prayer Statement of Faith in the *Booklet* (also online under About Us).
- Become familiar with the Core Values of Moms in Prayer International online under About Us.
- Abide by Moms in Prayer Policies in the *Booklet* (also online under About Us).
- Ask God for at least one other woman with whom you can pray.
- Choose a place and time convenient for you to meet.
- Register as a Church-based Group at www.MomsInPrayer.org: include the leader's name, information and the school(s) being prayed for. To receive Moms in Prayer emails, please add email@MomsInPrayer.org to your email address book.
- Encourage your members to go online and register as a member, or with their permission you may register them as members on their behalf.

Helpful suggestions

- Offer to teach the Moms in Prayer International prayer curriculum, *Igniting a Passion to Pray*, as a way to introduce the ministry to the church.
- Share the one-page handout Benefits to the Local Church that is available online under About Us.
- Supply the church with publicity resources, available online, for the various promotional venues in the church (bulletin inserts, promotional DVD, poster, etc). For more information, visit Get the Word Out on the Moms in Prayer website.
- A Prayer Sheet is a valuable tool to use during the time of prayer. Partially filled-in Prayer Sheets are available under Leaders Corner at www.MomsInPrayer.org.
- During the intercession time, please consider the following:
 - Have each member choose one child to pray for that week.
 - Pray for that child's school or future school.
 - Divide into smaller groups of twos or threes if the size of the group allows. Consider dividing by schools or by the ages of the children.
