## Language-based Groups

The mission of Moms in Prayer International, an interdenominational prayer ministry previously named Moms In Touch, is to impact children and schools worldwide for Christ by gathering mothers to pray regularly (weekly is optimal). Women that come together based on a language other than English, such as Spanish, Korean, Chinese or Russian, can register as a Language-based Group. Groups can meet in a home, at a church, in a park or at another central location. Moms in Prayer groups may NOT meet on a school campus, unless it is a Christian school.

### To begin

- Read the *Booklet* thoroughly and become familiar with the Four Steps of Prayer and One Accord Praying.
- Agree with the Moms in Prayer Statement of Faith in the *Booklet* (also online under About Us).
- Become familiar with the Core Values of Moms in Prayer International online under About Us.
- Abide by Moms in Prayer Policies in the *Booklet* (also online under About Us).
- Ask God for at least one other woman with whom you can pray.
- Choose a place and time convenient for you to meet.
- Register as a Language-based Group at [www.MomsInPrayer.org](http://www.MomsInPrayer.org): include the leader's name, information and the school(s) being prayed for. To receive Moms in Prayer emails, please add [email@MomsInPrayer.org](mailto:email@MomsInPrayer.org) to your email address book.
- Encourage your members to go online and register as a member, or with their permission you may register them as members on their behalf.

### Helpful suggestions

During the intercession time:

- Divide into smaller groups of twos or threes if the size of the group allows. If more than one school is being prayed for, consider dividing by schools or by the ages of children.
- Suggest that each member choose one child to pray for that week.
- Pray for that child's school or the chosen area school.
