## Military Groups

The mission of Moms in Prayer International, an interdenominational prayer ministry previously named Moms In Touch, is to impact children and schools worldwide for Christ by gathering mothers to pray (weekly is optimal). Mothers with daughters or sons serving in the military may choose to pray with a Career Group or form their own Military Group. A Military Group is two or more women in the same geographic area who meet to pray for the unique needs of their sons and daughters serving in the military. In keeping with the mission of Moms in Prayer International, groups that have no naturally designated school to pray for will choose a school in their area which does not have its own Moms in Prayer group, or the child's alma mater, and pray on behalf of the teachers, the administration and students during intercession.

### To begin

- Read the *Booklet* thoroughly and become familiar with the Four Steps of Prayer and One Accord Praying.
- Agree with the Moms in Prayer Statement of Faith in the *Booklet* (also online under About Us).
- Become familiar with the Core Values of Moms in Prayer International online under About Us.
- Abide by Moms in Prayer Policies in the *Booklet* (also online under About Us).
- Ask God for at least one other woman with whom you can pray.
- Choose a place and time convenient for you to meet.
- Register as a Military Group at [www.MomsInPrayer.org](http://www.MomsInPrayer.org): include the leader's name, information and the school(s) being prayed for. To receive Moms in Prayer emails, please add [email@MomsInPrayer.org](mailto:email@MomsInPrayer.org) to your email address book.
- Encourage your members to go online and register as a member, or with their permission you may register them as members on their behalf.

### Helpful suggestions

- Have each member choose one child to pray for that week.
- Pray for the military school or chosen area school each week.
- Divide into smaller groups of twos or threes if the size of the group allows.
