Traditional Groups

The mission of Moms in Prayer International, an interdenominational prayer ministry previously named Moms In Touch, is to impact children and schools worldwide for Christ by gathering mothers to pray regularly (weekly is optimal). The Traditional Group usually meets in a home; however, some may choose to meet at a public, central location such as a park, church, etc. Unless the group prays for a Christian school, it may NOT meet on the school campus.

To begin

- Read the *Booklet* thoroughly and become familiar with the Four Steps of Prayer and One Accord Praying.
- Agree with the Moms in Prayer Statement of Faith in the *Booklet* (also online under About Us).
- Become familiar with the Core Values of Moms in Prayer International online under About Us.
- Abide by Moms in Prayer Policies in the *Booklet* (also online under About Us).
- Ask God for at least one other woman with whom you can pray.
- Choose a place and time convenient for you to meet.
- Register as a Traditional Group at www.MomsInPrayer.org: include the leader's name, information and the school(s) being prayed for. To receive Moms in Prayer emails, please add email@MomsInPrayer.org to your email address book.
- Encourage your members to go online and register as a member, or with their permission you may register them as members on their behalf.

Helpful suggestions

- A Prayer Sheet is a valuable tool to use during the time of prayer. Partially filled-in Prayer Sheets are available at www.MomsInPrayer.org under Leaders Corner.
- During the intercession time, please consider the following:
 - Have each member choose one child to pray for that week.
 - Divide into smaller groups of twos or threes if the size of the group allows.
- To accommodate women's schedules, there may be multiple Moms in Prayer groups for the same school.
- A mom who has not found another mom from her school to pray with, or whose children live in another area, may join another Traditional Group until she finds another woman with whom she can pray.
- A teacher may join a Traditional Group if her own child attends that school.
