



Multiple-School Groups Church-based

The mission of Moms In Touch International, an interdenominational prayer ministry, is to impact children and schools worldwide for Christ by gathering mothers to pray (weekly is optimal). Women in a local community may choose to meet together to pray for their children and the schools they attend in an area church. Several schools and all ages of kids may be represented. During the intercession time, members are grouped into the age level of their children or similar schools. Ideally, each school represented would be prayed for each week.

To Begin

- Read the *MITI Booklet* thoroughly and become familiar with the *Four Steps of Prayer* and *One Accord Praying*.
- Agree with the MITI Statement of Faith (*MITI Booklet*).
- Become familiar with the Core Values of Moms In Touch (www.MomsInTouch.org>About Us).
- Abide by MITI Policies (*MITI Booklet*).
- Contact the pastor or women's ministry director of the church for permission to start a church-based group. Share the Benefits of MITI Women in the Church sheet.
- Ask God for at least one other mom/grandmother with whom you can pray. Your children do not have to attend the same school.
- Choose a convenient place and time to meet. You might want to consider a time when the church is providing childcare for those who need it.
- Register the group at www.MomsInTouch.org. Include the leader's name and information.
- Encourage your members to go online and register as a member, or with their permission you may register them as members on their behalf.

Helpful Suggestions

- Offer to teach the MITI prayer curriculum, *Igniting a Passion to Pray* as a way to introduce Moms In Touch to the church.

- **During the intercession time, please consider the following:**
 - Have each member choose one child to pray for that week.
 - Pray for that child's school or future school.
 - Divide into smaller groups of twos or threes if the size of the group allows.
