



School-Specific Groups Preschool

The mission of Moms In Touch International, an interdenominational prayer ministry, is to impact children and schools worldwide for Christ by gathering mothers to pray (weekly is optimal). Mothers with preschoolers can either form a school-specific MITI group praying for the preschool the children attend or a group to pray for their preschool children who are not attending school yet. In keeping with the mission of Moms In Touch International, multiple-school groups that have no naturally designated school to pray for will choose a school in their area which does not have its own MITI group and pray on behalf of the teachers, the administration and students during intercession.

To Begin

- Read the *MITI Booklet* thoroughly and become familiar with the *Four Steps of Prayer* and *One Accord Praying*.
- Agree with the MITI Statement of Faith (*MITI Booklet*).
- Become familiar with the Core Values of Moms In Touch at www.MomsInTouch.org>About Us.
- Abide by MITI Policies (*MITI Booklet*).
- Ask God for at least one other mother with whom you can pray. Your children do not have to attend the same preschool.
- Choose a place and time that are convenient for you to meet.
- Register the group at www.MomsInTouch.org: include the leader's name and information.
- Encourage your members to go online and register as a member, or with their permission you may register them as members on their behalf.

Helpful Suggestions

- Have each member choose one child to pray for that week.
- Pray for that child's preschool or chosen area school.
- Divide into smaller groups of twos or threes if the size of the group allows.
