



Preschool

The mission of Moms In Touch International, an interdenominational prayer ministry, is to impact children and schools worldwide for Christ by gathering mothers to pray regularly (weekly is optimal). Preschool groups may form as a School-Specific Group and pray for their children and the preschool they attend. If your child is not yet attending school, or if you want to meet with moms whose children attend different preschools, you may form a Multiple-School Group. In this format, each mother would pray for the school their child attends or choose a school in your area that does not have anyone praying for it and/or a school where your child might attend in the future.

To begin

- Read the *MITI Booklet* thoroughly and become familiar with the Four Steps of Prayer and One Accord Praying.
- Agree with the MITI Statement of Faith in the *MITI Booklet* and online under About Us.
- Become familiar with the Core Values of Moms In Touch International online under About Us.
- Abide by MITI Policies in the *MITI Booklet* and online under About Us.
- Ask God for at least one other woman with whom you can pray.
- Choose a place and time convenient for you to meet.
- Register the group at www.MomsInTouch.org: include the leader's name and information, as well as the school(s) being prayed for.
- Encourage your members to go online and register as a member, or with their permission you may register them as members on their behalf.

Helpful suggestions

The MITI Prayer Sheet is a valuable tool to use during the time of prayer. Partially filled-in Prayer Sheets are available under Leaders Corner at www.MomsInTouch.org. During the intercession time, please consider the following:

- Have each member choose one child to pray for that week.
- Pray for that child's preschool or chosen area school.
- Divide into smaller groups of twos or threes if the size of the group allows.
