



Multiple-School Groups Prodigal

The mission of Moms In Touch International, an interdenominational prayer ministry, is to impact children and schools worldwide for Christ by gathering mothers to pray (weekly is optimal). A mom with a prodigal can feel isolated. Gathering together to pray can help break through the isolation. They may choose to pray with a school-specific MITI group or they may form their own group. A prodigals group is two or more mothers in the same geographic area who meet to pray for their prodigal children and the schools they attend. In keeping with the mission of Moms In Touch International, if the children are not attending a school, choose a school in their area which does not have its own MITI group or the child's alma mater and pray on behalf of the teachers, the administration, and students during intercession.

To Begin

- Read the *MITI Booklet* thoroughly and become familiar with the *Four Steps of Prayer* and *One Accord Praying*.
- Agree with the MITI Statement of Faith.
- Become familiar with the Core Values of Moms In Touch, www.MomsInTouch.org>About Us
- Abide by MITI Policies.
- Ask God for at least one other woman with whom you can pray.
- Choose a place and time convenient for you to meet.
- Register the group at www.MomsInTouch.org: include the leader's name and information.
- Encourage your members to go online and register as a member, or with their permission you may register them as members on their behalf.

During the intercession time, please consider the following:

- Have each member choose one child to pray for that week.
