



MOMS IN TOUCH INTERNATIONAL

Multiple-School Group: Children with Special Needs

The mission of Moms In Touch International, an interdenominational prayer ministry, is to impact children and schools worldwide for Christ by gathering mothers to pray (weekly is optimal). A mom with a “special needs” child can feel isolated. Gathering together to pray can help break through the isolation. They may choose to pray with a school-specific MITI group or form their own Children with Special Needs group. In keeping with the mission of Moms In Touch International, if there is no naturally designated school to pray for, choose a school in the area which does not have its own MITI group and pray on behalf of the teachers, the administration, and students during intercession.

To Begin

- Read the MITI Booklet thoroughly and become familiar with the Four Steps of Prayer and One Accord Praying.
- Agree with the MITI Statement of Faith (MITI Booklet).
- Become familiar with the Core Values of Moms In Touch (MITI website, About Us).
- Abide by MITI Policies (MITI Booklet).
- Ask God for at least one other mother with whom you can pray. Your children do not have to be at the same school.
- Register the group at www.MomsInTouch.org: include the leader’s name and information.
- Encourage your members to go online and register as a member, or with their permission you may register them as members on their behalf.

Helpful Suggestions

- A prayer sheet is a valuable tool to use during the time of prayer. Filled-in prayer sheets are available at www.MomsInTouch.org, under the Leaders Corner.
- During the intercession time, please consider the following:
 - Have each member choose one child to pray for that week.
 - Pray for that child’s school or chosen area school.
 - Divide into smaller groups of twos or threes if the size of the group allows.
